Creative Commons License

Creative Commons licenses give everyone from individual creators to large institutions a standardized way to grant the public permission to use their creative work under copyright law. From the reuser's perspective, the presence of a Creative Commons license on a copyrighted work answers the question, What can I do with this work?

Creative Commons Licenses

Creative Commons (CC) licenses are free copyright tools that let creators decide how others can use their work. They range from very open to more restrictive:

- cc **BY** Free use with credit.
- **CC) BY-s** Same as above, but adaptations must use the same license.
- cc) BY-Nc Noncommercial use only, with credit.
- cc) **BY**-ND Noncommercial + ShareAlike.
- **BY-NC** No changes allowed, credit required.
- Most restrictive: noncommercial, no changes, credit required. CO

Licenses are IRREVOCABLE and only the copyright holder can apply them.



Sadhguru: Jagadish "Jaggi" Vasudev

Sadhguru, born **Jaggi Vasudev** (3 September 1957), is an Indian yogi, mystic, and author. He is the founder of the **Isha Foundation**, a non-profit spiritual organization established in 1992, which offers yoga programs, social outreach, education, and environmental initiatives worldwide.

Early Life: Born in Mysuru, Karnataka; studied English literature at the University of Mysore.

Spiritual Experience: In 1982, he had a profound mystical experience on Chamundi Hill, which became the turning point of his life.

Isha Foundation: Established in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu; known for the Dhyanalinga yogic temple and the annual Mahashivratri celebrations.

Initiatives:

- Rally for Rivers and Cauvery Calling campaigns for river revitalization.
- Save Soil Movement (2022) to address soil degradation globally.

Books: Author of bestsellers like Inner Engineering: A Yogi's Guide to Joy and Death: An Inside Story.


Recognition: Honored with the **Padma Vibhushan** (2017), India's second-highest civilian award, for his contributions to spirituality.







Library Team Wants You to Know that The Ashoka Centre for Translation at Ashoka University, in collaboration with the New India Foundation, has launched <u>Bhashavaad</u>, India's first non-profit, open-access, crowd-sourced database of Indian translations. Starting with over 14,000 entries, 6,500+ authors, and 7,000+ translators, the database aims to revitalize India's translation ecosystem, providing a valuable inventory of the country's literary and cultural identity. Bhashavaad strives to answer questions like what is and what is not being translated, who is publishing translations, who is translating, which languages are most active, what are the most translated language pairs, and many more besides the dynamics between languages, the communities that use them, and the regions they belong to.
