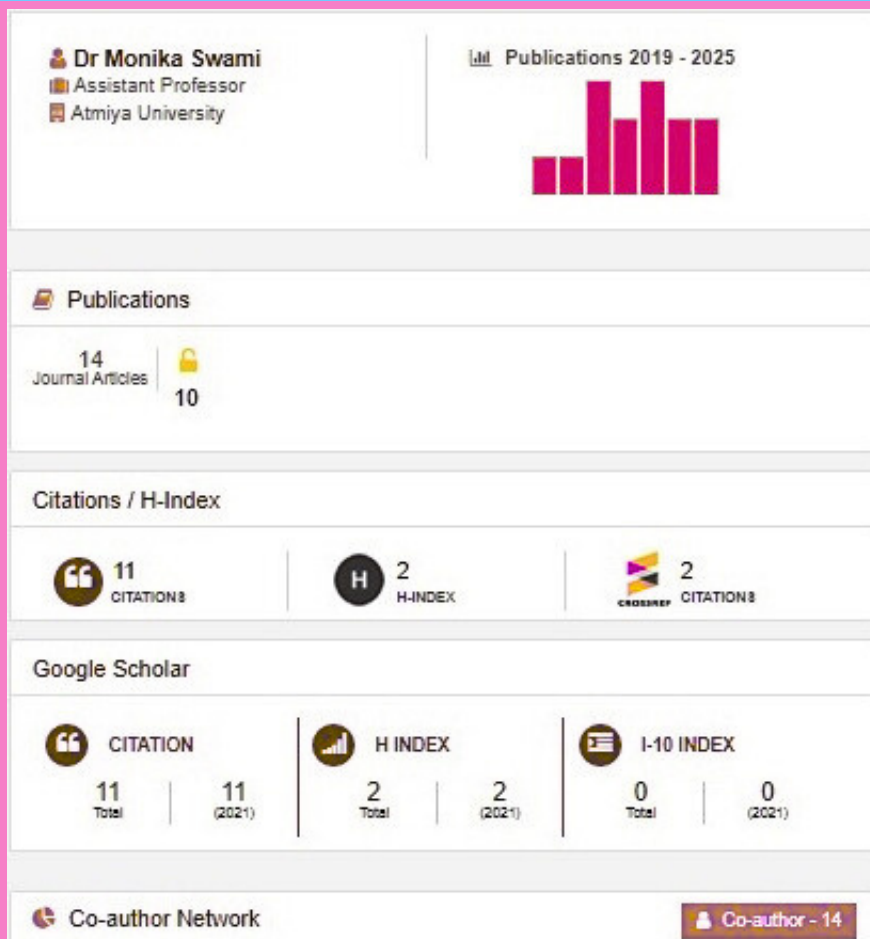

Ayn Rand

Ayn Rand (1905–1982) was a Russian-American novelist and philosopher best known for developing Objectivism, a philosophy that champions reason, individualism, and laissez-faire capitalism. Born in St. Petersburg, she later moved to the United States, which she saw as the land of individual freedom.

Her most famous novels are **The Fountainhead** and **Atlas Shrugged** both featuring strong, independent protagonists who refuse to conform to society's expectations.

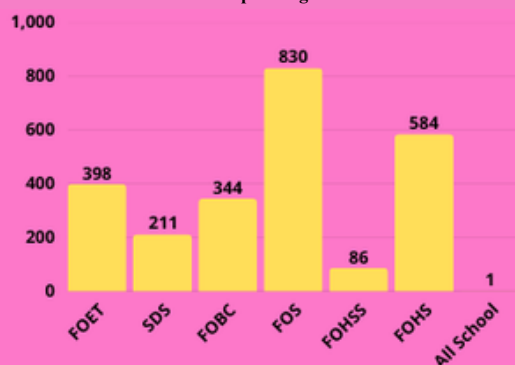
Rand believed that rational self-interest and personal achievement were moral ideals. Love her or debate her, she remains one of the most influential and controversial thinkers of the 20th century.

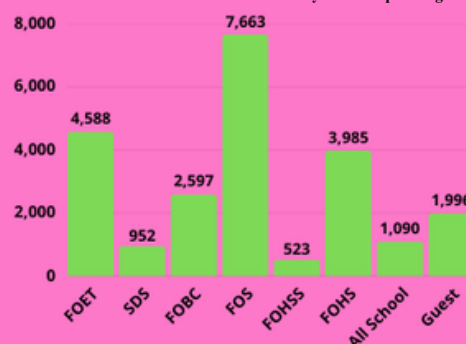
Book Transaction Statistics

"This chart illustrates book transaction statistics - monthly, department-wise, and categorized by circulation and reference helping identify user trends and support effective library resource planning"



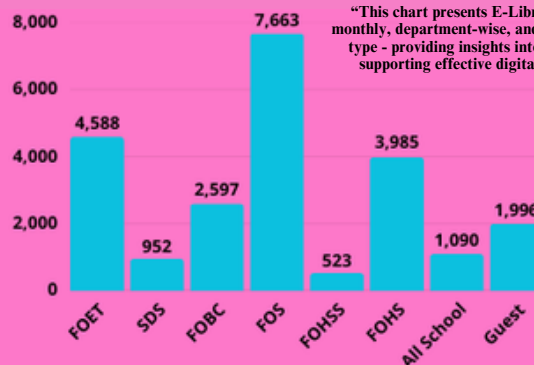
Reading Usage Statistics
