SCImago Journal & Country Rank

SCImago Journal & Country Rank (SJR) is a free, publicly accessible platform that provides rankings and performance indicators for scholarly journals and countries based on data from the Scopus database. Developed by the SCImago research group, the portal helps researchers, librarians, academicians, and students assess the visibility and impact of scientific publications.

The **SJR indicator** measures a journal's scientific influence by considering not only the number of citations received but also the prestige of the journals from which those citations originate. This approach is similar to the PageRank algorithm used in web search, where citations from highly influential journals carry greater weight.

One of the most widely used features of SCImago is its quartile ranking system. Journals are classified into four **quartiles: Q1** (top 25%), **Q2**, **Q3**, and **Q4** within their respective subject categories. Researchers often use these rankings to identify reputable journals for publishing their work and to evaluate research quality.

The platform covers thousands of journals across numerous subject areas and also provides country rankings, citation analysis, journal comparison tools, and visualization features. By offering transparent and accessible bibliometric data, SCImago supports informed decision-making in research, publication, and academic assessment.

ATMIYA University IRINS: Showcasing Research Excellence

The Institutional Research Information System (IRINS) of Atmiya University serves as a comprehensive platform for managing, showcasing, and evaluating the scholarly achievements of the University's faculty members and researchers. The portal provides a centralized repository of research publications, citations, patents, projects, professional activities, and academic profiles.

IRINS is developed and supported by the Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre under the University Grants Commission (UGC). The system integrates with globally recognized academic identifiers such as ORCID, Scopus Author ID, Web of Science Researcher ID, and Google Scholar, enabling automatic aggregation and tracking of research outputs.

At present, the Atmiya University IRINS portal features more than 278 faculty and researcher profiles and records over 1,000 scholarly publications across diverse disciplines including Engineering, Science, Pharmacy, Management, Commerce, Humanities, and Computer Science.

The portal highlights research productivity, citation impact, h-index values, funded projects, doctoral guidance, awards, and collaborative networks. It enables researchers to increase the visibility of their work while helping students, faculty, and external stakeholders identify subject experts and research strengths within the University.

Through IRINS, Atmiya University demonstrates its commitment to fostering a strong research culture, promoting interdisciplinary collaboration, and enhancing the global visibility of its academic contributions. The platform serves as an important tool for research assessment, institutional ranking, and scholarly communication.

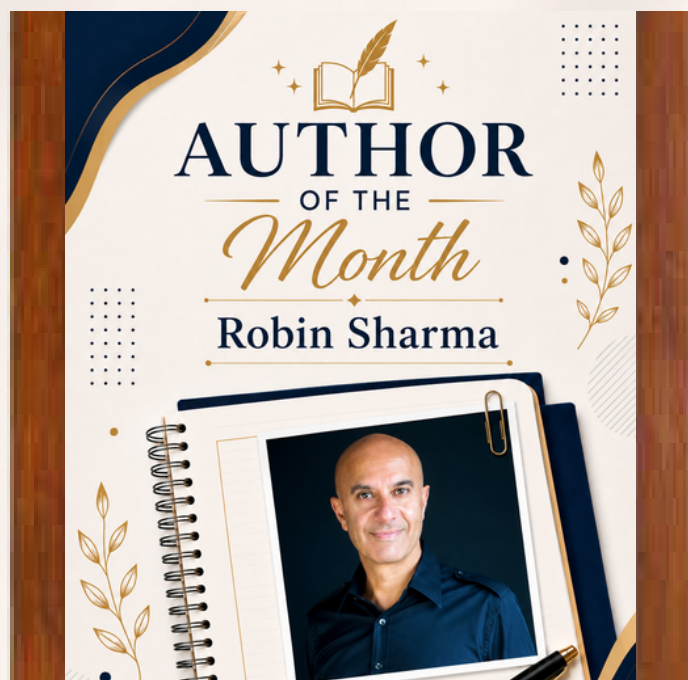

Robin Sharma is a Canadian author, leadership expert, motivational speaker, and former lawyer. He is best known for writing the bestselling book *The Monk Who Sold His Ferrari*, which has inspired millions of readers worldwide.

Early Life

Born in Uganda in the mid-1960s to a family of Indian origin. His family later immigrated to Canada, where he was raised in Nova Scotia and Manitoba. He studied at Dalhousie University and earned a law degree before beginning a legal career.

Career Transition

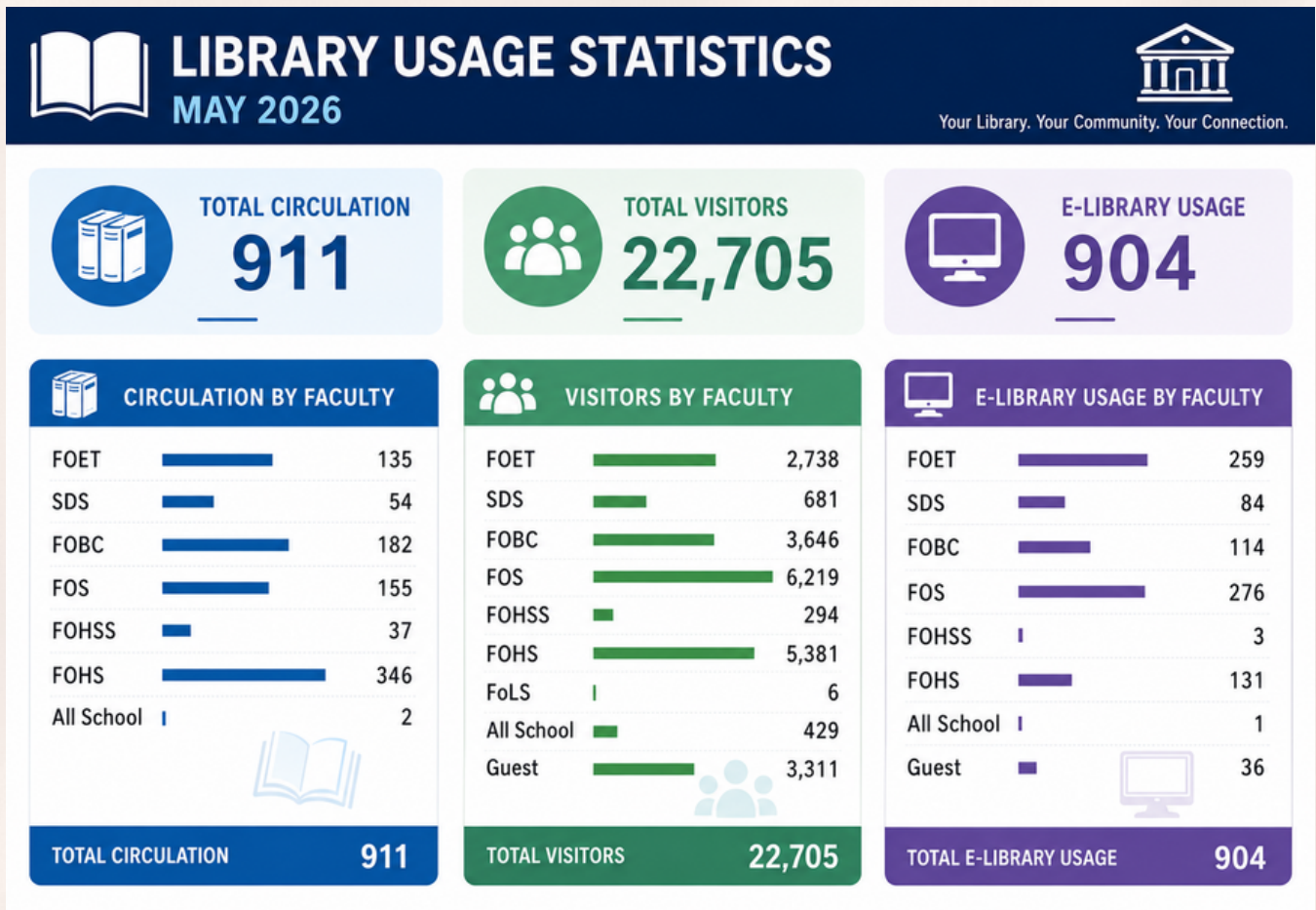
Sharma worked as a litigation lawyer and for the Canadian Department of Justice. Unsatisfied with his legal career, he began studying personal development, leadership, and spirituality. At age 25, he self-published his first book, *MegaLiving!*, and later self-published *The Monk Who Sold His Ferrari*. The book's success led him to leave law and become a full-time author and speaker.
