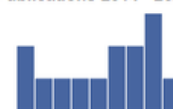

Dr. Nidhi Saxena is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Life Sciences (Microbiology) at Atmiya University. She holds an M.Sc., Ph.D., and GSET qualification and has over 11 years of teaching and research experience. She completed her Ph.D. from Saurashtra University in 2025.

Dr. Saxena's research interests include **Biotechnology, Applied Microbiology, Probiotics, Metabolomics, and Proteomics**. Her research focuses on **gut microbiota, probiotic microorganisms, functional foods, medicinal plants, and microbial biotechnology** for improving human health and nutrition. She is currently leading a research project on "Influencing Gut Microbiota to Reduce Malnutrition in the Gujarat Region" and has also completed a Government of Gujarat (SSIP) funded project on mushrooms as a high-protein food source.

She has authored **6 publications**, including **5 journal articles, book chapters, and a book**. Her notable research includes characterization of probiotic *Lactobacillus* isolates from Gujarat, development of plant-based probiotic yogurt, phytochemical studies on medicinal plants, and microbial bioremediation of textile dyes. Her research impact includes **6 citations with an h-index of 1 (IRINS)**, reflecting her growing contributions to microbiology and biotechnology research.

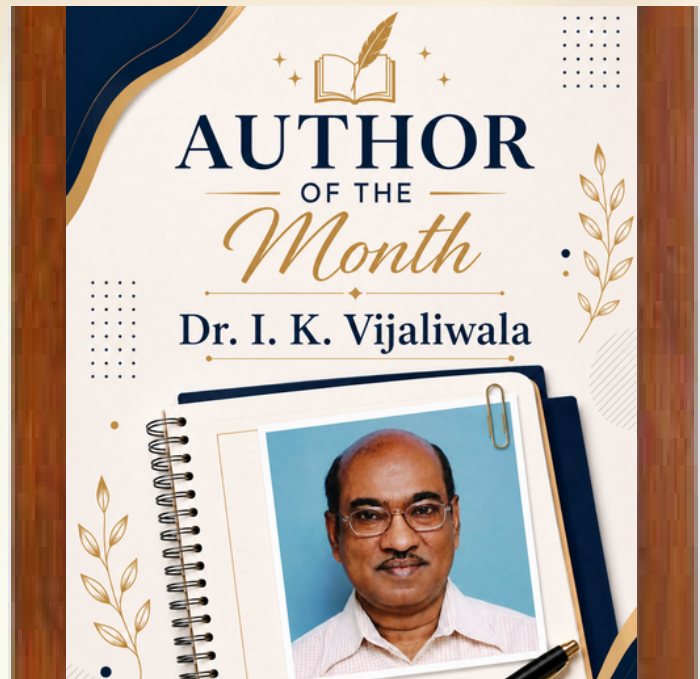

Dr. I. K. Vijaliwala (Ikram K. Vijaliwala) is a distinguished Gujarati author, pediatrician, motivational speaker, and social worker from Bhavnagar, Gujarat. He is widely respected for his contributions to children's healthcare and for his inspirational writings that encourage positive thinking, self-improvement, and compassionate living. Born into a modest family, Dr. Vijaliwala overcame financial hardships through determination and dedication to education, experiences that deeply influenced his philosophy of life.

As a pediatrician, he has devoted decades to serving children and their families. Beyond his medical practice, he has been actively involved in humanitarian work, particularly supporting children with thalassemia through voluntary blood donation initiatives and other community welfare activities. His commitment to service has earned him recognition as an "Angel Doctor."

Dr. Vijaliwala began his literary journey in the early 2000s and has since authored more than twenty Gujarati books. His works cover themes such as personal growth, relationships, emotional well-being, spirituality, and life values. Written in a simple yet thought-provoking style, his books have inspired readers of all ages and have sold hundreds of thousands of copies across Gujarat and among Gujarati communities worldwide.

Through his dual roles as a physician and author, Dr. I. K. Vijaliwala continues to inspire people to lead healthier, happier, and more meaningful lives.
