Key Features

- Digital Repository: Serves as a platform for depositing and accessing theses/dissertations.
- Supports academic transparency and knowledge sharing.
- Comprehensive Database: Contains research across diverse disciplines.
- Includes work from universities and research institutions nationwide.
- Open Access: Ensures free and unrestricted access to research outputs.
- Promotes visibility and usage of academic research.
- UGC Mandate: Universities are required to deposit Ph.D. theses in Shodhganga to prevent duplication of research and ensure originality.
- Integrated Tools: Offers a plagiarism detection service through "Shodh Shuddhi" to uphold academic integrity.

Key Features:

Citation Metrics: Calculates hindex, g-index, i10-index, and more.

Data Sources: Pulls data from platforms like Google Scholar, Scopus, CrossRef, and PubMed.

Free to Use: Available for free, making it accessible to researchers globally.

User-Friendly: Simple interface to extract citation data.
