It was established in 1995 by William G. Bowen, the president of Princeton University, to assist libraries in managing the storage and preservation of journal back issues. JSTOR offers an extensive archive of scholarly literature, with many journals' complete back issues available from their inception.

The platform supports academic research and education by offering reliable and full-text scholarly resources. It covers various fields, including humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, and more. While access to JSTOR is primarily subscription-based, a portion of the content is freely available to the public through programs like "Register & Read" and "Early Journal Content." This makes JSTOR an invaluable resource for researchers, educators, and students, providing them with access to a wealth of credible and peer-reviewed academic materials.

Journal finder tools

Here are some popular journal finder tools that help researchers identify suitable journals for their manuscripts:

Elsevier Journal Finder: Assists authors in finding suitable Elsevier journals based on their article's title and abstract.

Springer Journal Suggester: Uses the article's title and abstract to suggest relevant Springer journals.

IEEE Publication Recommender: Helps authors find suitable IEEE periodicals for their manuscripts.

Wiley Journal Finder: Provides suggestions for Wiley journals based on the article's title and abstract.

Journal/Author Name Estimator (JANE): Analyzes the article's title and abstract to suggest journals indexed in PubMed.

Edanz Journal Selector: Recommends journals from various publishers based on manuscript details.

SAGE Journal Recommender: Helps find relevant SAGE journals by analyzing the article's abstract.

Emerald Journal Finder: Suggests suitable Emerald journals for an article.

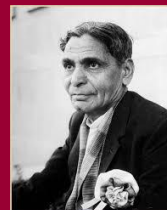

Author of the month:

Pannalal Patel



Pannalal Patel (1912–1989) was a prominent Indian Gujarati language author known for his significant contributions to Gujarati literature. Born in Mandli village, Gujarat, he started his literary career with short stories and later became renowned for his novels. Patel writing oftendepicted rural life and the struggles of the common man, reflecting the socio-economic conditions of his time.

His most famous work, “**Manvi Ni**

Bhavi” (Endurance: A Droll Saga),

published in 1947, is considered a classic in Gujarati literature and won

the Jnanpith Award in 1985,

India's highest literary honor.

Patel wrote over 50 novels and numerous short stories, earning a lasting legacy as one of Gujarat literary giants.
